Buellton Recreation Summer Camp Parent Information Sheet

Drop-off and Pick-up

Camp Hours are 8:00 am-5:30 pm

Please drop off campers no later than 9:30 am. Campers will return to the Rec Center no later than 4:00 pm. If you need to pick your child up earlier than 4:00 pm, please arrange at drop-off to meet up with the camp. You must pick your child up no later than 5:30 pm.

Sign-In and Sign-Out

An adult/guardian must be present at drop-off and pick-up and must sign the child in and out each day. *If someone else is picking up your child, please put that in the comment section of the sign-in sheet at drop off.*

Meals & Snacks

It is important to make sure your child has had a healthy breakfast each morning before they come, or bring one with them to eat when they get here. Please pack a large, **healthy** lunch and plenty of water daily for your child. Children may bring a small mid-morning snack and Camp will provide an afternoon snack. If your child has allergies or is on a special diet, we will do our best to have snacks available. Please provide an extra afternoon snack for them just in case they do not like or cannot have the Camp snack.

Toys and Electronics

Please leave all toys and stuffed animals at home! Valuables such as electronic devices, i.e.: cell phones, Smart watches, Kindles, iPods, etc are **not allowed** at camp.

Sunscreen

Please put sunscreen on your child every single day *before* camp. Counselors will remind them to reapply mid-day.

Medications

If your child needs medication to be taken at camp, please let the staff know. Please note any and all medical needs and medications on your registration form.

Belongings/Lost and Found

Please make sure to label all of your child's belongings and check the Lost and Found area weekly.

Field Trips

Children are expected to follow all rules of the facilities we will be visiting throughout the summer. Please do not send extra money with your child for snacks, souvenirs, etc. All admission fees and activity costs are covered in the weekly camp costs.

Camp Behavior Expectations

Parents/Guardians—please review this camp behavior information with your kids so we can all have a fun and safe summer experience!

Camper Behavior Expectations:

- Take RESPONSIBILITY...if they do something wrong, we expect them to admit it and try their best to make it right.
- Treat staff and all campers with kindness and respect.
- Respect the property of camp and others.
- RESPECT others' feelings and differences.
- Have fun and be willing to try new things.
- Have a GOOD ATTITUDE, even when it isn't their preferred activity.
- Use appropriate language.
- Ask for help from a counselor when they have a problem or see others facing an issue.
- Be responsible for their belongings.
- Stay with their group.
- Keep their hands to themselves at all times.

The following behaviors will not be allowed or tolerated:

- Fighting, rough housing or engaging in unsafe behavior.
- Threatening or bullying anybody or joining in when others are bullying somebody.
- Taking things that don't belong to them.
- Being disrespectful to staff or other campers. This includes "trash talking" or being intentionally mean.
- Lying to other campers or counselors.
- Disobedience of counselor directions.

Depending on the severity of the situation (or if the behavior persists), one or more of the following consequences will be taken.

1. Counselor will discuss behavior with the camper and parent/guardian.
2. Child will be removed from the activity for the day.
3. The child will be sent home immediately for the day.
4. Child is removed from the camp for the rest of week.
5. Child will be removed from camp for the rest of the summer.

There are no refunds when a child's behavior requires he/she be sent home.
